FHWA is excited to present a series of INVEST brown bag lunch sessions at this year's TRB Annual Meeting. These sessions will provide a brief introduction to INVEST, FHWA's self-evaluation tool for the voluntary assessment of sustainable agency practices in transportation system planning, project development, and operations and maintenance.

The sessions will begin with a general introduction to INVEST and include presentations from agencies who have successfully applied INVEST to illustrate the tool's effectiveness in encouraging efficiency, cost-savings, and sustainability throughout the transportation life-cycle. Agencies presenting include: Washington State DOT, Illinois Tollway, North Central Texas Council of Governments, and the Cape Cod Commission.

The agency example presentations will be followed by a question and answer session to allow the opportunity for agencies interested in implementing INVEST to engage with the existing user community and FHWA staff. The session will also allow agency staff to compare and discuss their unique experiences and tactics in the application of INVEST. Additional materials and resources necessary for the tool's deployment will be provided at the conclusion of each session.
